What's more, we also process materials that would appear, at first glance, to be impossible to recycle. Hazardous waste for example. We are constantly carrying out work to develop new technologies so that more and more raw materials can be recovered and returned to production cycles.

Many of our innovative recycling solutions are developed at REMONDIS' Lippe Plant – the largest industrial recycling centre in Europe. This site is home to a whole range of different facilities, such as plants for processing and recycling gypsum from flue gas desulphurisation systems, chemicals, wood, plastics, e-waste and non-fossil fuels. 900,000 tonnes of recycled products leave the Lippe Plant every single year.






A mere 2.5% of the world's water supplies is suitable as drinking water. All the more reason, therefore, why every effort should be made to protect this valuable resource. This is exactly what we do at REMONDIS by providing a full range of professional and sustainable services that go far beyond the norm.

Seeing the whole picture

We can perform every single task that may be required by industrial businesses, local authorities and local inhabitants. From sourcing and producing process and drinking water all the way through to treating wastewater in sewage treatment plants or on site at our industrial customers. And all this accompanied by a wide range of innovations, state-of-the-art processes and customer-oriented services to help preserve our planet's supplies of water and protect the environment.

From the well to the tap

Supplying drinking water is a complex procedure. First, the water must be extracted from reservoirs, deep wells or other sources and then sent to a waterworks so it can be processed. What's more, a well-functioning network with pumping stations, storage facilities and pipes is needed to transport the water to the consumers. Thanks to our expertise, technology and specialist staff, we are able to operate in all these different areas. Just one example here is the work we perform at waterworks where we run the multi-stage process to transform water into drinking water.

Our staff provide technical and scientific advice that includes microbiological, biological and chemical analyses and sample-taking as well as software that can microscopically analyse activated sludge at sewage treatment plants

Wastewater treatment - the whole works

We offer the public, industrial and private sectors an extensive range of services when it comes to treating wastewater and returning it to the water cycle. In sewage treatment plants, for example, we deploy state-of-the-art mechanical, biological and chemical processes to transform wastewater back into clean water. Our portfolio of wastewater management services include:

- operating wastewater networks from beginning to end
- property drainage systems
- creating water cycles at production plants
- inspecting, repairing and installing household connections

Exemplary material flow management

Over the years, we have developed processes that not only enable all types of wastewater to be treated but also the residual substances in the water to be recycled and put to good use. At the moment, we have certificates showing we can re-use over 270 substances. Here are just a few examples of the products and services that are based on our recycling concepts:

- high calorific refuse-derived fuel made from dried sewage sludge
- recovery of phosphorus from wastewater or sewage sludge
- generating biogas from industrial wastewater on site at our customers' premises
- supplying the agricultural sector with legally compliant biosolids

Services covering all things H₂O

Our water management portfolio is rounded off by a wide range of services that allow us to pool together our know-how and experience and create tangible benefits for specific target groups. We have, for example, developed an IT-based service system which local authorities can use to manage and control all their water-related tasks – from gathering data, to managing water rates and charges, all the way through to renovating their municipal water and wastewater networks. Moreover, we offer comprehensive analytical services for local authorities as well as private sector customers such as farmers.
